

## David Alan Woycke

David was born on December 1st 1946 at St. Joseph Memorial Hospital in Kokomo, Indiana, second son of Mary Margaret and Louis George Woycke.

David spent his early years in Kokomo where his dad worked for Delco Radio. In 1950 the Woyckes moved to Plymouth, Indiana where his dad worked for John Meck Industries (they made early TV's, including the early color sets with the round tubes). In 1967 the family moved to South Bend Indiana where dad worked for Bendix Missile Systems on the TALOS surface to air missile. In November, 1961 the Woycke family moved to Ann Arbor, Michigan where his dad began work at Argus Optics.

David Graduated from Ann Arbor High School in 1965.

He attended the University of Michigan in Ann Arbor - but did not graduate.

In 1973 he entered the Navy and became an Operations Specialist (Read Radar Operator).

Unfortunately, he developed a severe bout of colitis that rendered him incapable of shipboard service so he was sent to the Naval Hospital at Annapolis, Maryland where he was discharged from active service.

Thus David began his illustrious career in Electronic Marine Equipment Sales - First for a Marine Electronics Store in Annapolis, and then to the Seattle Region working for Motorola Marine Electronics.

Eventually, he left Motorola and became a salesman with SILO Electronics, working first in Austin, Texas, and then in San Diego.

In 1995 SILO closed their doors and David began working for Cloud 9 Transportation here in San Diego. David worked for Cloud 9 for many years and had numerous tales of transporting the rich and famous until beginning his carrier with TSA in 2002.

As you know, David passed away on April 1st, 2013.

David is survived by his older brother Ken, sister-in-law Kris, niece Elizabeth Anne (Woycke) Radford, nephew John Kenneth Woycke, and 5 great nieces.
