Lou Kyprie, 89, died at her home in Traverse City, MI on July 12, 2005. Lou was born on September 18, 1915 in Saskatchewan, Canada, the daughter of Dr. Cameron Smith and Clarice Leighton Smith. After completing training as a nurse in Kingston, Ontario, she took a job at the University Hospital in Ann Arbor. She subsequently worked in Detroit as a dental nurse, where she met and married Dr. P.M. Kyprie. After her husband's death in 1952, Lou went back to school, graduating with a Bachelor of Science in Public Health Nursing and later a Master of Arts degree from the University of Michigan. For 25 years, she was a beloved school nurse, counselor, and second mom to thousands of students at Ann Arbor High and then at Huron High School. For the past 16 years she has been a resident of Traverse City. Lou is survived by her children Christine Potter of Blooming ton, IN and Paul Kyprie of Whit more Lake; and her brother, Dr. Donald Smith of Ann Arbor.
